This individual will define, develop, test, analyze and maintain new software applications, as well as build, support and maintain the College's SQL Server 2008 database.

As a Developer, you will be responsible for:

- Designing, developing and implementing applications to meet business requirements and goals using .NET/Java, C#, Crystal Reports, API, and SQL application development tools;
- Building interfaces between the College and third party systems;
- Participating in all phases of application development, including planning, requirement analysis, development, testing and implementation;
- Providing application support;
- Analyzing business processes and practices to identify and recommend opportunities for enhancement;
- Conduct walkthroughs to maintain development of best practices and code optimization.

As a DBA you will:

- Perform day-to-day database administration tasks;
- Participate in user requirement analysis, database design;
